

In its fifth year, the **2014 Global Entrepreneur Indicator (GEI)** is a twice-yearly gauge of the near-term global economic outlook that delivers data on job creation, profit outlook and access to capital, among other key metrics. The Entrepreneurs' Organization's September GEI—taken by 2,851 leading entrepreneurs—reveals the current state of 46 countries' business landscapes and economic health, among other statistics designed to identify economic trends, drive fiscal growth and strengthen communities.

Entrepreneurs indicate increase in full-time staffing levels

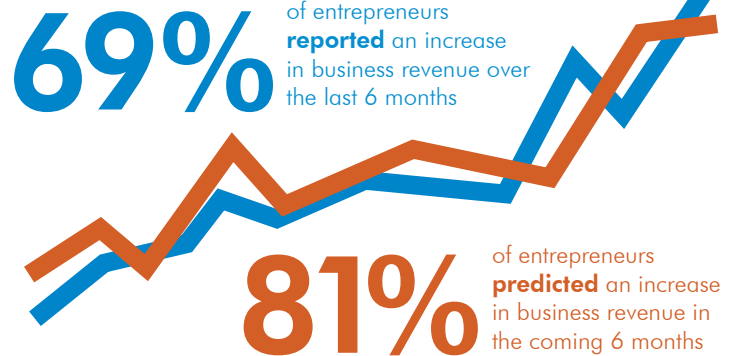

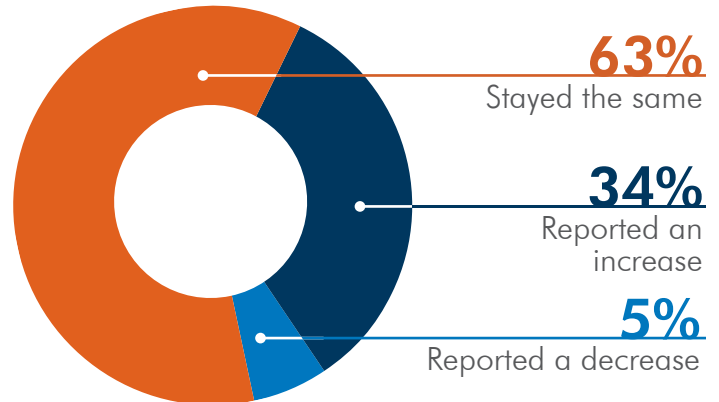
Entrepreneurs cite willingness to start a new business in the current economic environment

Respondents report increased funding opportunities during past six months

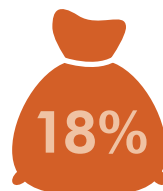


PROFIT OUTLOOK
